Stewardship

"Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples."

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us the two great commandments -- First, you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. Second, you shall love your neighbor as yourself. These commandments not only encompass all 10 commandments given to Moses, they also encompass Stewardship, as we define it in our diocese. To be "fully alive as missionary disciples" requires us to recognize and receive God's gifts and to share those gifts in love of God and neighbor. Whether you proclaim God's word as a lector, hold a regular hour of Adoration, serve on a committee, volunteer in a classroom, or serve your elderly parents, visit a sick neighbor, or even participate in the election process as a citizen, you are practicing Stewardship. When you do these things out of love (rather than obligation), you are showing your dedication God and your neighbor. The scribe in today's reading understood that love for God and neighbor is worth more than all the burnt offerings and sacrifices man could offer. Clearly love is key to discipleship.

GAINING A PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE SOULS IN PURGATORY

From November 1-8, Catholics in a state of grace who visit a cemetery and pray there for the dead can receive a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory.

The conditions for the indulgence are:

- 1) devoutly visit and pray for souls of the deceased, even if only mentally for the departed
Prayers such as: "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let the perpetual light shine upon them. And may the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen."
- 2) receive Holy Communion each day you seek an indulgence
- 3) to go to **Confession** within 20 days before or after the indulgence (Going to Confession once covers many indulgences)
have no attachment to sin (even venial)
- 4) pray at least one Our Father and Hail Mary for the intentions of the Holy Father
