ST. JOSEPH PARISHIONERS:

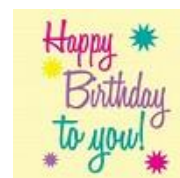
We will not have Mass this Tuesday, January 15th at 5:00 PM but we will welcome everyone to assist in removing the Christmas decorations and placing them in storage.

Pastor's Corner

To end the Christmas Season the Church celebrates yet another feast, the Baptism of the Lord. Jesus' public ministry starts with His baptism. The Gospels primarily focus on the three years of Jesus' public life.

The first of the sacraments we receive is baptism, where we become a child of God and have the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. It washes away our sins, both original and personal if we were baptized later in life.

Jesus gave us seven sacraments: Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony, Holy Orders, Anointing of the Sick. The Catechism paragraph 1210 says, "The seven sacraments touch all the stages and all the important moments of Christian life: they give birth and increase, healing and mission to the Christian's life of faith. There is a certain resemblance between the stages of natural life and the stages of the spiritual life."

What is a sacrament? Paragraph 1131 in the Catechism says, "The sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us. The visible rites by which the sacraments are celebrated signify and make present the graces proper to each sacrament. They bear fruit in those who receive them with the required dispositions." To put it in simpler terms, it is an "outward side instituted by Christ of an inward grace".

God made mankind both material and spiritual, body and soul. To know that we are receiving His graces through the sacrament God unites a material object and / or words to know we are receiving His grace. When we see water poured on the head of someone and the words are said, we know that person is being baptized. When the priest says in Confession, "and I absolve you of your sins" you know that your sins are forgiven by God.
