**Stewardship Bulletin Bit**

Once again Jesus is challenging us to be good stewards and to be fully alive. Is our giving of self-done out of gratitude, or is it in the expectation of something in return? Do we hold it over Jesus' head in our own times of need? Jesus says love your enemies and lend expecting nothing back...for He Himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked (that's us). Take, for example, David in today's first reading. David had the opportunity to kill Saul and declare victory in a violent and arrogant way. Instead, he took the king's spear, declaring victory in a much more subtle and merciful way. He declared that, "The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness." David understands that he is cooperating with God's plans and is a faithful steward. Likewise, Luke 6:38 says, "For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you." If we are to be deserving of abundant mercy, then we are to give mercy abundantly. We are being called to give generously, and to the point of vulnerability.

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

It is easier for us to love someone when we are loved in return. To love and to be loved are a good thing. We want to be around people who we know love us.

Today's gospel passage challenges each of us not only to love those who love us but also to love our enemies. Because of our weak sinful nature, our tendency might be to seek revenge. Jesus warns us that if we only love and do good to those who we expect something in return, what good is that. Everyone wants something in return. Jesus encourages us to go beyond of expecting something in return.

When we look at the life of Jesus, He was not always liked or loved. Even from a young age, His life was threatened. But He always loved not only those who loved Him but even those who wanted to harm Him as well. His death on the cross was not only for those whom He love, but for all of mankind.

As we approach the season of Lent, may we reflect in our own life to see if there is someone that we do not get along with. Maybe this is a family member or coworker. Pray for that person and will them good. Maybe the situation will resolve and the two of you will see eye to eye again. But maybe it won't, maybe you'll go through life continuing to pray for this person. But that is alright, because the Lord knows your intention of willing good to this person.
